



WHAT IF IT'S TRUE . . . THAT GOD MADE MANKIND IN HIS IMAGE?

The following passages and questions will guide our live discussion on Jan. 23. If you would like, you may prepare for class by reading through these passages and thinking through the questions in advance. Preparation is not required.

READ GENESIS 1:26,27; GENESIS 2; AND GENESIS 3

Consider: What are several things that make the creation of Adam and Eve different than the rest of creation? How do you understand the image of God?

READ GENESIS 5:3 AND GENESIS 9:6

Consider: How is the image of God described in a post-fallen world? If the doctrine of the image of God is true, how does that affect your own value and worth? How does it affect your view of others? How might it affect the way you interact with those you disagree with?

READ COLOSSIANS 3:5-12 AND ROMANS 12:9-21

Consider: Considering all of the above passages, ask yourself, "What if this is true? What does that mean for me right now in my relationship with myself, with others, and with God?"
